



# Perception of the current state of inter-Korean relations






## Who is responsible for the current tension between the two Koreas?






# Who is responsible for the sinking of the *Cheonan*?





## Who is responsible for the sinking of the Cheonan? - by age group








## Who is responsible for the sinking of the *Cheonan*?


by presidential approval rating








# How likely is a war between the two Koreas?






#### Why do you think that a war is unlikely?



Technical college attendance/withdrawal/graduate


Lower than high school diploma








#### The U.S. favored by age group




## Do you think that South Korea alone can win a war against North Korea?






## Do you think that South Korea alone can win a war against North Korea?

by education level






## Do you think that South Korea alone can deter North Korea from starting a war?






## South Korea alone can deter North Korea from starting a war - by education level




## Will China intervene on behalf of North Korea in the event of a war?






# Do you think that the ROK-U.S. alliance will continue to be necessary in the future?




China is likely to intervene on behalf of N.Korea in the event of a war

China is not likely to intervene on behalf of N.Korea in the event of a war








## How do you feel about North Korea's development of nuclear weapons?


by the perceived likelihood of South Korea's winning a war against




## How do you feel about North Korea's development of nuclear weapons?

- by presidential job approval






# Who is most responsible for the failure to resolve the North Korean nuclear problem?






### Who is most responsible for the non-resolution of the North Korean nuclear problem?

# What policy do you think is desirable in dealing with the North Korean nuclear threat?




- Continuous Military pressure

- US should guarantee the survival of the N.Korean regime




### What policy do you think is desirable in dealing with the North Korean nuclear threat?

by U.S. favorability






# Do you think that the US will use nuclear weapons to defend South Korea from North Korea's nuclear attacks?






# Do you think that the U.S. will use nuclear weapons to defend South Korea if the North attacks the South? - by age group








# Do you think that the U.S. will use nuclear weapons to defend South Korea if the North attacks the South? - by U.S. favorability






### Do you think that the U.S. will use nuclear weapons to defend South Korea if the North attacks the South?

- by the perceived need for ROK-US alliance






